
Research Question

How can we develop ESP courses and materials for interculturally-minded dietitians who wish to serve local communities?

Needs Analysis



- 1. Target Situation Analysis (TSA): in-service people
- 2. Learning Situation Analysis (LSA):Subject needs, felt needs (wants)
- 3. Present Situation Analysis (PSA): teachers, learners, materials, classrooms, curriculum



Research Design

National Survey on EFL teachers, faculty members specializing in dietetics, and administrator who belong to institutions for training dietitians in Japan toward English language programs and materials

Duration: November 18, 2011 – December 31, 2011 No. of Samples: 139 respondents from

Preliminary Research on Foreign Residents

- 1.Misunderstanding and Lack of Knowledge about Religious Taboos of Food, Habits of Vegetarians, Food Allergies
- 2.Gender Issues surrounding Cooking and Eating Out
- 3. English Language Needs for Intercultural Communication about Eating Habits


Research Results

There are wide gaps in attitude between EFL teachers and Specialist teachers, Teachers in 4 year universities and 2 year colleges, toward ESP for dietitians

Specialist teachers and teachers in 4 year universities are more aware of English language needs for dietitians in the future as well as needs for English for academic purposes

More than 60% of institutions do NOT provide ESP for dietitians and more than 80 % of teachers feel students' EFL proficiency problematic when teaching English
